## Program Description

Early-On is a family-centered program that serves children with special needs, aged birth to 18 months. Each child and parent(s) or caregiver will work with experienced pediatric professionals in a small group setting in the fields of occupational, speech, and physical therapy; and cognitive development. A licensed nurse is also a member of the team to provide ongoing medical advice and support.

Parents will participate in parent support, family training and advocacy groups to foster their confidence, knowledge, and ability to care for their child.
