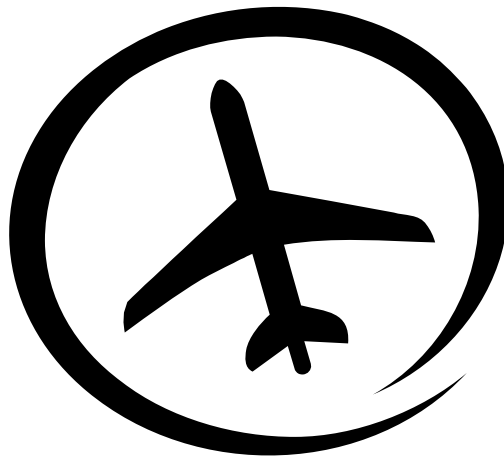

Team Captain/Adult Sponsor Responsibilities Junior Youth Team

(Please Note the Following)

- Ensure that the Team Participation Contract is signed and sent to Special Kids & Families office.
- Recruit team members and ensure that you have 10 people signed up to be on your team.
- Ensure that your team raises a minimum of \$300 for your entry fee.
- Encourage your team to raise additional pledge money (above the entry fee amount) to support Special Kids and Families.
- Ensure that the parent/guardian of ALL team members signs the Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, Indemnity, and Photo Consent form. Forms may be mailed to the office prior to the event or can be turned in at Team Captain Registration on the day of the event.
- Complete and send in the team's T-shirt order by September 1st, 2008.
- Ensure that your team member understand the Plane Pull[®] rules and ensure that rules are followed.
- Ensure that your team knows when to arrive and where to go when they arrive to the event for your team meeting.
- Register your team at the Team Registration Table on the day of the Pull.
- Ensure that the team reports to the Team Photo area when called.

Team Recruitment Ideas

- Hold an informal Plane Pull[®] awareness meeting at your home, church, school, organization or your parent's place of business.
- Send a mass email out to friends, neighbors and family. Get your parents to send an email to co-workers asking people to participate.
- Create a flyer or use ours. Place flyers up in key locations asking for participation and/or pledges.
- Start a team recruitment chain. Start by finding one person to join the team. Then have that person find one person. And that person find one person until have 10 team members. In other words, each person is responsible for recruiting one team member.

2008 Plane Pull[®] Rules

Junior Youth Team Competition

For your team to be eligible for the Plane Pull[®] competition (to win a trophy), the following conditions must be met:

- 1) A junior youth team is made up of 10 participants. No more than 10 people are allowed to pull the plane.
- 2) Team member must be 11-14 year of age or in the 6th – 8th grade in school.
- 3) Special kids and Families must receive full payment of your team's entry fee prior to pulling the plane. Teams that have not paid the entry fee will not be allowed to pull the plane, unless special arrangements have been made with Special Kids and Families.
- 4) Each person pulling the plane for your team must be registered as a team member for your team.
- 5) The parent/guardian of each team member must read and sign Release Form for minor prior to pulling the plane.
- 6) Individuals may participate on only one team.
- 7) Individuals may wear gloves.

Pull Order

- 1) The pull order is established by random drawing.
- 2) The MC of the event will call each team when it is time for the team to take their picture. The MC will give three calls. If the full team is not present in the photo area at the final call, the team will automatically drop to the end of the pull order.

Rules will be strictly enforced to assure fairness for the event. Any deviation will result in disqualification from the event.

2008 Plane Pull[®] Competition

Overall Fastest Pull

The first even component will involve all junior teams competing for the fastest time in which the ATR Feeder Aircraft can be pulled 20 feet.

Fastest Pull in a Category

The second event component will involve junior youth teams competing against other junior teams in a specific category. It takes five or more teams to form a specific category. Examples include "church youth group," "Boy Scout group," "Sports team." Scores from the Overall Fastest Pull contest will be used to determine winners of each category.

Most Spirited

A trophy will be awarded to the senior youth team that exhibits the most team spirit and showmanship. Teams will be judged on creativity, enthusiasm, appearance, and sound.

Most Pledge Money Raised

A prize will be awarded to the team that raised the most money above the \$300 entry fee.
